ENTITLEMENTS:

ACTIVE DUTY:

Under North Carolina General Statue Section (G.S.) 116-143.3 certain members of the armed services and their dependent relatives may be eligible to be charged a tuition rate less than the out-of-state rate whether or not they qualify as residents for tuition purposes under G.S. 116-143.3.

VETERAN:

Chapter 30, 33, or 35 students - Under North Carolina General Statue Section (G.S.) 116-143.3A certain veterans and other individuals entitled to federal education benefits under 38 U.S.C. Chapter 30 or 38 U.S.C. Chapter 33 or Chapter 35 may be eligible to be charged the in-state tuition rate and applicable mandatory fees for enrollment without satisfying the 12-month residency requirement under G.S. 116-143.1, under certain qualifying conditions.

Chapter 31 students - Section 301 of Public Law 115-251 amended title 38 of the United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 3679(c) states that effective for courses, quarters, semesters, or terms beginning after March 1, 2019, a public institution of higher learning (IHL) within the United States (U.S.), as well as U.S. Territories, must charge the resident rate to VR&E participants who reside in the State or U.S. Territory.

Please Note: all students must first complete the residency process through The North Carolina Residency Determination Service (NC RDS). This application cannot be accepted until the NC RDS application is completed.

I understand that if it is determined that I am not eligible for the in-state tuition rate then I will be responsible for and charged at the out-of-state rate.
